By application accepted for filing December 21, 2005, Point-2-Point Inc., a District of Columbia entity, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with one van. Applicant's proposed tariff contains rates for transportation under the District of Columbia Medicaid program, an hourly charter rate, and individual fares for transportation to and from Ronald Reagan Washington National and Washington-Dulles International Airports.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than January 27, 2006, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than February 10, 2006, an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing is February 10, 2006, and that copies must be served on applicant's president, Teres L. Hargraves-White, 3040 Hollins Lane, Waldorf, MD 20601.
