Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 419 for a minimum of \$5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

The \$1 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement and the \$5 million excess WMATC Insurance Endorsement on file for respondent terminated on January 1, 2006, without replacement. As a result, Certificate No. 419 was automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-02 and a \$50 late filing fee became due and payable under Regulation No. 67-03(c), as noted in Order No. 9236, served January 5, 2006.

Respondent tendered \$50 in cash on January 9, 2006, and filed an acceptable \$1 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement and a \$5 million excess WMATC Insurance Endorsement on January 13, 2006. Accordingly, the suspension is lifted, and this investigation is terminated.
