By application accepted for filing January 13, 2006, Good Samaritan Transportation LLC, a Maryland entity, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with one van. Applicant's proposed tariff contains rates for transportation under the District of Columbia Medicaid program and non-Medicaid rates for similar service.

Attached to the application as Exhibit C is a Maryland certificate of good standing dated September 3, 2004. According to the Maryland Department of Assessments and Taxation website, as of January 26, 2006, applicant is no longer in good standing. Applicant will be directed to file a current certificate of good standing.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than February 14, 2006, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than February 28, 2006, an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than February 28, 2006, a current certificate of good standing issued by the Maryland Department of Assessments and Taxation.

4. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing is February 28, 2006, and that copies must be served on applicant's manager, Kwame A. Mayes, 2511 Lorrington Drive, District Heights, MD 20747.
