Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 462 for a minimum of \$5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum. Under Regulation No. 67-03(c), \$50 is due and payable upon the failure of a carrier to timely file an acceptable WMATC Insurance Endorsement.

The \$5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on file for respondent expired on January 31, 2006. A \$5 million primary replacement endorsement was filed on January 30, 2006, but it is not acceptable for filing because the carrier address on the endorsement does not match the carrier address on file with the Commission.¹ Certificate No. 462, therefore, is automatically suspended and may be revoked if respondent fails to file the necessary WMATC Insurance Endorsement(s) and pay the \$50 late filing fee within thirty days.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That respondent shall not transport passengers for hire under Certificate No. 462, unless and until otherwise ordered by the Commission.

2. That Certificate No. 462 shall be subject to revocation pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact, if respondent fails to file the necessary WMATC Insurance Endorsement(s) and pay \$50 by money order, certified check, or cashier's check within thirty days.
