Notice of this application was served on January 13, 2006, in Order No. 9261, and applicant was directed to publish further notice in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than January 27, 2006 and file certain other documents no later than February 10, 2006.

On February 2, 2006, applicant filed a request for an extension of the publication deadline.

The publication deadline shall be extended as requested. A new protest and document submission deadline, which is determined by reference to the publication deadline, shall be established, as well. Applicant shall timely publish notice with the new protest deadline.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than February 17, 2006, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than March 3, 2006, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than March 3, 2006, a written statement explaining why applicant has submitted proposed rates for transportation in minibuses, vans, and sedans, even though no such vehicles are included in applicant's vehicle list.

4. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than March 3, 2006, a written statement explaining why, according to the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration, the only carrier at applicant's address with federal authority is Expert Transportation Inc.

5. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is March 3, 2006, and that copies must be served on applicant's secretary, Karen Joynes, 10517 Broad Leaf Drive, Largo, MD 20774.
