This matter is before the Commission on applicant's request for reconsideration of the voiding of authority conditionally granted to applicant in Commission Order No. 8763, served June 8, 2005.

Order No. 8763 specified that applicant would have the full 180 days available under Commission Regulation No. 66 to satisfy the conditions of the grant. Applicant did not fully comply with the prescribed conditions within the allotted time. The conditional grant consequently became void on December 6, 2005. Under Article XIII, Section 4(a), applicant had until January 5, 2006, to file an application for reconsideration.<sup>1</sup>

Respondent timely filed an application for reconsideration as of December 12, 2005, but the application does not allege any error on the part of the Commission as required by statute.<sup>2</sup> The application therefore is denied. However, considering that applicant has fully satisfied the conditions of issuance prescribed in Order No. 8763, we will reopen this proceeding on our own initiative<sup>3</sup> and issue Certificate of Authority No. 1072.<sup>4</sup>

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Certificate of Authority No. 1072 shall be issued to Best Care Medical Transportation, Inc., 12936 Lockleven Lane, Woodbridge, VA 22191.
