These proceedings were initiated on November 1, 2005, in Order Nos. 9084 and 9085 for the purpose of investigating respondent's failure to file an annual report for 2004 and pay a \$100 annual fee for 2005. Together, the orders gave respondent thirty days to file the annual report, pay the annual fee, and pay a combined civil forfeiture of \$200 and fifteen days to request an oral hearing. The orders stated that Certificate No. 597 would stand suspended and be subject to revocation without further proceeding upon respondent's failure to timely comply. Respondent has yet to respond.

Accordingly, Certificate No. 597 shall be revoked pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact for respondent's willful failure to comply with Order Nos. 9084 and 9085; provided, that the unpaid 2005 annual fee, unfiled 2004 annual report and \$200 combined forfeiture shall remain due.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 597 is hereby revoked.

2. That within 30 days from the date of this order respondent shall:

- a. remove from respondent's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61;
- b. file a notarized affidavit with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding requirement; and
- c. surrender Certificate No. 597 to the Commission.
