This proceeding was initiated on November 1, 2005, in Order No. 9085 for the purpose of investigating respondent's failure to file an annual report for 2004. The order gave respondent thirty days to file the report and pay a civil forfeiture of \$100 and fifteen days to request an oral hearing. The order stated that Certificate No. 290 would stand suspended and be subject to revocation without further proceeding upon respondent's failure to timely comply. Respondent has yet to respond.

Accordingly, Certificate No. 290 shall be revoked pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact for respondent's willful failure to comply with Order No. 9085; provided, that the unfiled 2004 annual report and \$100 forfeiture shall remain due.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 290 is hereby revoked.
2. That within 30 days from the date of this order respondent shall:
 - a. remove from respondent's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61;
 - b. file a notarized affidavit with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding requirement; and
 - c. surrender Certificate No. 290 to the Commission.
