By application accepted for filing March 23, 2006, William Henry Alex, a sole proprietor, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.

Applicant's proposed tariff contains rates for transportation under the District of Columbia Medicaid program, but applicant's vehicle list, Exhibit A, is missing. Applicant will be directed to file an Exhibit A.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than April 14, 2006, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than April 28, 2006, an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than April 28, 2006, an Exhibit A containing a list of revenue vehicles indicating the make, model, seating capacity, and number of vehicles applicant will use initially, plus copies of registrations for any revenue vehicles already in applicant's possession.

4. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing is April 28, 2006, and that copies must be served on applicant's representative, Bahta G. Yohannes, 7620 Helmsdale Place, Manassas, VA 20109.
