The Commission conditionally granted an application to amend Certificate No. 342 in Case No. AP-2005-120 last year,<sup>1</sup> but applicant failed to fulfill the conditions in a timely manner, thereby voiding the Commission's approval.<sup>2</sup> Applicant subsequently discontinued operating in the Metropolitan District and now seeks seeks voluntary termination of Certificate No. 342, the original of which applicant says has been misplaced.

The Commission may terminate a certificate of authority under Title II of the Compact, Article XI, Section 10(b), upon application by the holder.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 342 is hereby terminated, effective this date.

2. That within 30 days from the date of this order, applicant shall remove from its vehicles the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61 and file a notarized affidavit with the Commission verifying compliance.
