Certificate No. 950 has been suspended since February 5, 2006, for respondent's willful failure to comply with the insurance requirements specified in Regulation No. 58. Order No. 9303, served February 6, 2006, noted that Certificate No. 950 would be subject to revocation if respondent failed to file the necessary insurance endorsement(s) and pay a \$50 late fee within thirty days. Respondent paid the \$50 late fee but has yet to file the necessary insurance endorsement(s). In the meantime, on March 15, 2006, respondent filed an application requesting voluntary termination of Certificate No. 950.

The Commission may terminate a certificate of authority under Title II of the Compact, Article XI, Section 10(b), upon application by the holder. The application shall be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 950 is hereby terminated.
2. That within 30 days applicant shall:
 - a. remove from applicant's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61;
 - b. file a notarized affidavit with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding requirement; and
 - c. surrender Certificate No. 950 to the Commission.
