Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 789 for a minimum of \$5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

The \$2 million primary and the \$3 million excess WMATC Insurance Endorsements on file for respondent expired on March 12, 2006, without replacement. As a result, Certificate No. 789 was automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-02, and a \$50 late filing fee became due and payable under Regulation No. 67-03(c), as noted in Order No. 9385, served March 13, 2006.

Respondent filed an acceptable \$2 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on March 13, 2006, and an acceptable \$3 million excess WMATC Insurance Endorsement on March 16, 2006, and tendered \$50 in cash on April 10, 2006. Accordingly, the suspension is lifted, and this investigation is terminated.
