This matter is before the Commission on applicant's request for an extension of time in order to comply with Commission Order No. 8932, served August 31, 2005.

The order conditionally granted Certificate of Authority No. 1100 to applicant and specified that applicant would have the full 180 days available under Commission Regulation No. 66 to satisfy the conditions of the grant. On February 27, 2006 -- the 180th day -- applicant filed a request for an extension of the compliance deadline.

Commission Regulation No. 66 states that: "The time for complying with the conditions of a grant of authority shall not be extended beyond 180 days from the date of the grant."

Although Regulation No. 66 may be waived for good cause shown,¹ applicant's request fails to explain why applicant has yet to file any of the documents required by Order No. 8932 and also fails to propose a new deadline for compliance. Accordingly, applicant's request for an extension of time is denied.
