By application filed April 10, 2006, Hafiz Ahmed Badwi, trading as Decent Care Transportation, seeks voluntary termination of Certificate No. 948.

The Commission may terminate a certificate of authority under Title II of the Compact, Article XI, Section 10(b), upon application by the holder. The application shall be denied if applicant is not in good standing with the Commission.¹

Each carrier holding a certificate of authority on the first day of the calendar year must file an annual report and pay an annual fee on or before January 31 of that year.² Applicant held Certificate No. 948 on January 1 of this year and paid the annual fee on April 10, but applicant has yet to file an annual report. Consequently, applicant is not in good standing.³

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the application of Hafiz Ahmed Badwi, trading as Decent Care Transportation, for voluntary termination of Certificate No. 948 is hereby denied without prejudice.
