By application accepted for filing April 13, 2006, Advance Transportation Services, Inc., a Maryland entity, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations between points in the Metropolitan District.

Applicant's proposed tariff contains hourly group charter rates in sedans, limousines, vans, minibuses, SUV's and buses, but applicant's Exhibit A does not include the make, model, or seating capacity of any vehicle it plans to operate. Applicant will be directed to file an amended Exhibit A.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than May 3, 2006, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than May 17, 2006, an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than May 17, 2006, an amended Exhibit A, which includes a vehicle list containing the make, model, seating capacity, and number of vehicles applicant will use initially.

4. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing is

May 17, 2006, and that copies must be served on applicant's president,
Salim Haddad, P.O. Box 41011, Bethesda, MD 20824.
