By application accepted for filing April 21, 2006, Christopher Starghill, a sole proprietor trading as Starghill Limousine and Sedan Services, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with one sedan and one SUV. Applicant's proposed tariff contains mileage or hourly based rates.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than May 12, 2006, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than May 26, 2006, an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing is May 26, 2006, and that copies must be served on applicant at 2511 Brentwood Road, N.E., Washington, DC 20018.
