Notice of the application in Case No. AP-2006-103 was served on June 29, 2006, in Order No. 9698, and applicant was directed to publish further notice in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than July 13, 2006 and file certain other documents no later than July 27, 2006.

On July 14, 2006, applicant filed a request for an extension of the publication deadline.

In the meantime, on July 10, 2006, the \$1.5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on file for respondent, Earl Barnes, expired without replacement, resulting in the automatic suspension of Certificate No. 636 pursuant to Regulation No. 58-02.

The application and insurance proceedings shall be consolidated, and the publication deadline in Case No. AP-2006-103 shall be extended as requested. A new document submission deadline and protest deadline, which are determined by reference to the publication deadline, shall be established, as well. Applicant shall timely publish notice with the new protest deadline.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Case Nos. AP-2006-103 and MP-2006-109 are hereby consolidated pursuant to Commission Rule No. 20-02.

2. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than August 2, 2006, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

3. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than August 16, 2006, an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

4. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is August 16, 2006, and that copies must be served on applicant's representative, Earl G. Barnes, 1422 Webster Street, N.W., Washington, DC 20011.
