By application accepted for filing July 10, 2006, Ahmed Sadik, a sole proprietor trading as Asadik Limousine Services, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with one sedan. Applicant proposes operating under a tariff containing charter rates, mileage and/or hourly rates, individual and/or group sightseeing rates, airport shuttle rates, and rates for transportation under contracts with government agencies and private entities.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than August 2, 2006, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than August 16, 2006, an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing is August 16, 2006, and that copies must be served on applicant at 2411 Lyttonsville Road, #301, Silver Spring, MD 20910.
