By application accepted for filing July 14, 2006, Vision Transportation and Tours, Inc., a Virginia entity, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations between points in the Metropolitan District.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with one minibus. Applicant proposes operating under a tariff containing charter rates, mileage and/or hourly rates, and rates for transportation under contracts with private entities.

Applicant's mandatory Attachment A, a certificate of good standing from the Virginia State Corporation Commission is missing. Applicant will be directed to file a current certificate.

The application indicates applicant has other passenger carrier authority. Applicant will be directed to furnish information about its other authority.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than August 2, 2006, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than August 16, 2006, an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than August 16, 2006, a current certificate of good standing from the Virginia State Corporation Commission.

4. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than August 16, 2006, a copy of each motor carrier license, certificate or registration that applicant currently holds.

5. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing is August 16, 2006, and that copies must be served on applicant's president, Husam Atari, 4900 Leesburg Pike, #401, Alexandria, VA 22302.
