By application accepted for filing July 27, 2006, Leesburg Limo, Inc., a Virginia entity, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.


Applicant proposes commencing operations with one SUV. Applicant proposes operating under a tariff containing mileage and/or hourly rates. Because applicant has federal and/or state passenger carrier authority, applicant will be directed to furnish information about its other authority.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than August 18, 2006, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.
2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than September 1, 2006, an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.
3. That applicant shall file with the commission, no later than September 1, 2006, a copy of each motor carrier license, certificate or registration that applicant currently holds.
4. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing is September 1, 2006, and that copies must be served on applicant's representative, Amanda B. Smith, P.O. Box 6177, Leesburg, VA 20178.
