By application accepted for filing July 28, 2006, Roland I. Kamara, a sole proprietor trading as National Shuttle and Limousine Service, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with one van. Applicant proposes operating under a tariff containing charter rates, mileage and/or hourly rates, individual and/or group sightseeing rates, airport shuttle rates, rates for Medicaid transportation, and rates for transportation under contracts with government agencies and private entities.

Because applicant is in bankruptcy, applicant will be directed to furnish information about the current status of the proceeding.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than August 18, 2006, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than September 1, 2006, an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than September 1, 2006, a statement describing applicant's current bankruptcy status.

4. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing is

September 1, 2006, and that copies must be served on applicant at 11411 Sequoia Lane, Beltsville, MD 20705.
