Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 575 for a minimum of \$1.5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

The \$1 million primary and \$1 million excess WMATC Insurance Endorsements on file for respondent terminated on July 30, 2006, without replacement. As a result, Certificate No. 575 was automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-02, and a \$50 late filing fee became due and payable under Regulation No. 67-03(c), as noted in Order No. 9786, served July 31, 2006.

Respondent filed an acceptable \$1 million excess on August 8, 2006, tendered a \$50 money order on August 9, 2006, and filed an acceptable \$1 million primary on August 22, 2006. Accordingly, the suspension is lifted, and this investigation is terminated.
