By application accepted for filing August 16, 2006, AMA Limousine & Sedan, LLC, a Virginia entity, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with one sedan. Applicant proposes operating under a tariff containing mileage and/or hourly rates, individual and/or group sightseeing rates, airport shuttle rates, and rates for transportation under contracts with private entities.

The application indicates applicant has been investigated or found unfit by one or more transportation regulatory agencies in the past five years. Applicant will be directed to furnish information about the investigation(s) and/or finding(s).

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than September 6, 2006, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than September 20, 2006, an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than September 20, 2006, a statement: (1) identifying the agency or agencies that have investigated applicant and/or found applicant unfit; (2) describing the investigation(s) and/or finding(s); and (3) explaining applicant's current status.

4. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing is

September 20, 2006, and that copies must be served on applicant's representative, Ahmed Hasan Khan, 3830 Clore Place, Woodbridge, VA 22192.
