This proceeding was initiated in Order No. 9350 on March 1, 2006, for the purpose of investigating respondent's failure to maintain compliance with the Commission's insurance requirements.

Prior to this investigation, however, Order No. 9309 conditionally approved the transfer of respondent's assets, including Certificate No. 432, to Super Transport Incorporated, WMATC Carrier No. 989, and provided that upon Super Transport's compliance with the requirements of Order No. 9309, the Commission would reissue Certificate No. 989 to Super Transport, and Certificate No. 432 would stand revoked. Inasmuch as Super Transport timely complied with the conditions of Order No. 9309 and Certificate No. 989 has been reissued this day, Certificate No. 432 now stands revoked.

Accordingly, this proceeding is terminated; provided, that all outstanding fees and reports due from Med-Care, including the fees and report identified in Order No. 9350, shall remain due.
