By application accepted for filing August 24, 2006, Community Foundation For Group Homes Inc., a Maryland entity, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with a 7-passenger van and a 14-passenger minibus. Applicant proposes operating under a tariff containing charter rates, mileage and/or hourly rates, rates for Medicaid transportation, and rates for transportation under contracts with government agencies and private entities.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than September 25, 2006, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than October 10, 2006, an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing is October 10, 2006, and that copies must be served on applicant's representative, Rosamond I. McCormack, 8581 Greenbelt Road, #102, Greenbelt, MD 20770.
