By application accepted for filing September 8, 2006, Allan Faustin Deleon, a sole proprietor, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with one van. Applicant proposes operating under a tariff containing charter rates, individual and/or group sightseeing rates, airport shuttle rates, rates for Medicaid transportation, and rates for transportation under contracts with government agencies and private entities.

Because applicant has federal or state passenger carrier authority, applicant will be directed to furnish information about its other authority.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than October 6, 2006, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.
2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than October 20, 2006, an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.
3. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than October 20, 2006, a copy of each motor carrier license, certificate or registration that applicant currently holds.
4. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing is October 20, 2006, and that copies must be served on applicant at 5004 43rd Avenue, Hyattsville, MD 20781.
