By application accepted for filing September 18, 2006, Max Volcy, a sole proprietor trading as Volcy Max, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with one van. Applicant proposes operating under a tariff containing airport shuttle rates, rates for Medicaid transportation, and rates for transportation under contracts with government agencies and private entities.

Because applicant's principal place of business is in the District of Columbia, applicant will be directed to file proof of trade name registration with the District of Columbia Department of Consumer and Regulatory Affairs.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than October 10, 2006, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than October 24, 2006, an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than October 24, 2006, proof of trade name registration with the District of Columbia Department of Consumer and Regulatory Affairs.

4. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing is October 24, 2006, and that copies must be served on applicant at 7520 Eastern Avenue, N.W., Washington, DC 20012.
