Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 193 for a minimum of \$5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

The \$5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on file for respondent terminated on October 6, 2006, without replacement. As a result, Certificate No. 193 was automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-02, and a \$50 late filing fee became due and payable under Regulation No. 67-03(c), as noted in Order No. 9961, served October 6, 2006.

Respondent submitted a \$5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on October 10, 2006, and tendered a \$50 check on October 12, 2006. Accordingly, the suspension is lifted, and this investigation is terminated.
