By application accepted for filing October 11, 2006, Area One Transportation Company, a District of Columbia entity, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with one sedan. Applicant proposes operating under a tariff containing mileage and/or hourly rates, airport shuttle rates, and rates for transportation under contracts with private entities.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than November 8, 2006, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than November 22, 2006, an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing is November 22, 2006, and that copies must be served on applicant's representative, Olekanma Ekekwe, 2426 L'Enfant Square, S.E., Washington, DC 20020.
