By application accepted for filing October 12, 2006, Med Trans Plus, LLC, a Maryland entity, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.

Applicant proposes operating under a tariff containing private pay rates for wheelchair and ambulatory transportation. Applicant failed to indicate on its application form the number, type, or seating capacity of the vehicles with which it proposes commencing operations. Applicant will be directed to file a vehicle list containing the make, model, seating capacity, and number of vehicles applicant will use initially.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than November 8, 2006, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.
2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than November 22, 2006, an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.
3. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than November 22, 2006, a vehicle list containing the make, model, seating capacity, and number of vehicles applicant will use initially.
4. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing is November 22, 2006, and that copies must be served on applicant's representative, Deborah Marie Curtin, 7110 Fitzpatrick Drive, Laurel, MD 20707.
