By application accepted for filing October 23, 2006, Steve McCoy Boykins, a sole proprietor trading as Marcel's Limousine Service, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with one limousine and one sedan. Applicant proposes operating under a tariff containing mileage and/or hourly rates.

Because applicant has federal or state passenger carrier authority, applicant will be directed to furnish information about its other authority.

Because applicant has been investigated or found unfit by one or more transportation regulatory agencies in the past five years, applicant will be directed to furnish information about the investigation(s) and/or finding(s).

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than November 8, 2006, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than November 22, 2006, an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than November 22, 2006, a copy of each motor carrier license, certificate or registration that applicant currently holds.

4. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than November 22, 2006, a statement: (1) identifying the agency or agencies that investigated applicant and/or found applicant unfit; (2) describing the investigation(s) and/or finding(s); and (3) explaining applicant's current status.

5. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing is November 22, 2006, and that copies must be served on applicant at 925 Hillcrest Drive, Martinsburg, WV 25401.
