This matter is before the Commission on respondent's response to Order No. 9899, served September 11, 2006.

The order stipulated that upon respondent's payment of a \$4,000 civil forfeiture, the Commission would issue an order lifting the suspension of Certificate No. 127, subject to a one-year period of probation, provided respondent was in compliance with Commission Regulation No. 58.

Respondent tendered a \$4,000 check on October 18, 2006. Respondent later filed a \$1.5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement accepted for filing on November 15, 2006.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the suspension of Certificate of Authority No. 127 is hereby lifted.
2. That respondent shall serve a one-year period of probation, such that a willful violation of the Compact, or of the Commission's rules, regulations or orders thereunder, during the period of probation shall constitute grounds for immediate suspension and/or revocation of Certificate No. 127 without further proceedings, regardless of the nature and severity of the violation.
3. That this proceeding is terminated.
