Applicant proposes commencing operations with two vans. Applicant proposes operating under a tariff containing rates for transportation under contracts with government agencies.

Notice of this application was served on October 6, 2006, in Order No. 9963, and applicant was directed to publish further notice in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than October 20, 2006.

On October 30, 2006, applicant filed a request for an extension of the publication deadline. Order No. 10,047, served November 2, 2006, approved the request and extended the publication deadline to November 16, 2006.

On November 17, 2006, applicant filed an affidavit attesting to publication of notice in accordance with Order No. 9963, rather than Order No. 10,047. Once the latter order was issued, however, applicant was obliged to comply with it.¹

Under the circumstances, applicant will be directed to republish notice in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District. A new protest deadline, which is determined by reference to the publication deadline, shall be established, as well.

No further extensions will be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than December 5, 2006, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than December 19, 2006, an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is December 19, 2006, and that copies must be served on applicant's CEO, Awa Majad Al-Karim, 4 Professional Drive, #149, Gaithersburg, MD 20879.
