The \$1.5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on file for Quality Medical Transportation LLC, trading as F & J Healthcare Services, terminated without replacement on July 29, 2006. As a result, Certificate No. 512 was automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-02 as noted in Order No. 9785, served July 31, 2006.

On November 14, 2006, respondent filed an application requesting voluntary termination of Certificate No. 512. The Commission may terminate a certificate of authority under Title II of the Compact, Article XI, Section 10(b), upon application by the holder. The application shall be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 512 is hereby terminated, effective this date.
2. That within 30 days from the date of this order applicant shall:
  - a. remove from applicant's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61;
  - b. file a notarized affidavit with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding requirement; and
  - c. surrender Certificate No. 512 to the Commission.
