
Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 848 for a minimum of \$1.5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

The \$500,000 primary and \$1 million excess WMATC Insurance Endorsements on file for respondent terminated on November 21, 2006, without replacement. As a result, Certificate No. 848 was automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-02, and a \$50 late filing fee became due and payable under Regulation No. 67-03(c), as noted in Order No. 10,092, served November 21, 2006.

Respondent tendered a \$50 money order on November 22, 2006, and submitted a \$500,000 primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement and a \$1 million excess WMATC Insurance Endorsement on November 24, 2006. Accordingly, the suspension is lifted, and this investigation is terminated.
