Certificate of Authority No. 1294 was conditionally granted to Morcho Inc., a Maryland entity trading as 2M Medical Services, on October 6, 2006, in Order No. 9975, but the certificate has not been issued yet. Applicant is now requesting that a seating capacity restriction be added to Certificate of Authority No. 1294.

The restriction would confine applicant's operations to vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons, including the driver, thereby reducing from \$5 million to \$1.5 million applicant's minimum insurance obligation under Commission Regulation No. 58.

Under Article XI, Section 10(b), of the Compact, the Commission may amend a certificate of authority upon application by the holder. Applicant's request for a restrictive amendment includes a statement indicating that applicant plans to operate vans only, which generally seat fewer than 15 persons, including the driver. Accordingly, the application shall be approved.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

That upon applicant's timely compliance with the requirements of Order No. 9975, Certificate of Authority No. 1294, as amended consistent with this order, shall be issued to Morcho Inc., trading as 2M Medical Services, 12826 Camellia Drive, Silver Spring, MD 20906.
