Certificate No. 569 was automatically suspended on May 3, 2006, as a result of respondent's failure to timely file an annual report for 2005/2006 pursuant to Regulation No. 60-01, pay a \$150 annual fee for 2006 pursuant to Regulation No. 67-02, and pay the associated \$200 in late fees pursuant to Regulation No. 67-03.

Order No. 9537, served May 9, 2006, gave respondent thirty days to file the report and pay the fees or face revocation of Certificate No. 569. Respondent has yet to comply. In the meantime, the \$5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on file for respondent was cancelled effective September 1, 2006, and has not been replaced.

Certificate No. 569 shall be revoked pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact for respondent's willful failure to comply with Commission Regulation Nos. 60 and 67 and Commission Order No. 9537; provided, that respondent's unpaid \$150 annual fee for 2006, unfiled annual report for 2005/2006, and \$200 in late fees, shall remain due.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 569 is hereby revoked.
2. That within 30 days from the date of this order respondent shall:
 - a. remove from respondent's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61;
 - b. file a notarized affidavit with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding requirement; and
 - c. surrender Certificate No. 569 to the Commission.
