Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 896 for a minimum of \$1.5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

The \$1.5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on file for respondent terminated on December 6, 2006, without replacement. As a result, Certificate No. 896 was automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-02, and a \$50 late filing fee became due and payable under Regulation No. 67-03(c), as noted in Order No. 10,134, served December 6, 2006.

Respondent submitted a \$1.5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement and tendered \$50 cash on December 11, 2006. Accordingly, the suspension is lifted, and this investigation is terminated.
