This application was dismissed in Order No. 10,363, served March 28, 2007, for applicant's failure to submit a list of its shareholders and directors. On April 6, 2007, applicant filed a list of applicant's members as part of a request to reopen this proceeding.

Under Commission Regulation No. 26-01, a party may file "a petition to reopen [a] proceeding for the purpose of taking additional evidence. Such petition shall . . . conform . . . to the requirements of Rules 4 and 5." Rule 4-07 provides:

Except when service is required to be made by the Commission, every pleading, document, or other paper must, when filed or tendered to the Commission, include a certificate showing service and the method thereof upon all parties to the proceeding, and the name and address of each person served.

Applicant's request to reopen does not contain and is not accompanied by a certificate showing service on protestant, Executive Technology Solutions, LLC, WMATC Carrier No. 985. Accordingly, the request shall be denied.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the petition of Applied Business Management Solutions, Inc (ABMSI) LLC to reopen this proceeding is denied without prejudice to the filing of a new application.
