Certificate No. 1169 was automatically suspended on February 25, 2007, pursuant to Regulation No. 58-02, for respondent's willful failure to maintain on file with the Commission proof of \$1.5 million in combined-single-limit, motor vehicle liability insurance as required by Commission Regulation No. 58. Order No. 10,297, served February 26, 2007, noted that Certificate No. 1169 would be subject to revocation if respondent failed to file the necessary WMATC Insurance Endorsement(s), and pay a \$50 late fee within thirty days.

Respondent tendered \$50 in cash on March 13, 2007, and the Commission reissued Certificate No. 1169 to Comfort Ama Arthur, trading as El-Shaddai Transport, on May 25, 2007, pursuant to Order No. 10,258, served January 31, 2007, after Arthur, had filed, among other things, a \$1.5 million WMATC Insurance Endorsement.

Inasmuch as the late fee has been paid and Certificate No. 1169 is no longer held by respondent, this proceeding is terminated.
