
Certificate No. 1174 was revoked in Order No. 10,470, served May 9, 2007, pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact for respondent's willful failure to pay the \$50 late insurance fee under Regulation No. 67-03(c). Respondent subsequently paid the fee and filed an application for reconsideration.

Under Title II of the Compact, Article XIII, Section 4(a), an application for reconsideration of a Commission order must be filed within thirty days of its publication and state specifically the errors claimed as grounds for reconsideration. Respondent timely filed the application for reconsideration as of May 23, 2007, but the application does not allege any error on the part of the Commission. The application therefore is denied.

However, considering that respondent has paid the \$50 late insurance fee under Regulation No. 67-03(c), we will reopen this proceeding on our own initiative and reinstate Certificate of Authority No. 1174.<sup>1</sup>
