Certificate No. 1209 has been suspended since April 6, 2007, for respondent's willful failure to comply with the insurance requirements specified in Regulation No. 58. Order No. 10,391, served April 6, 2007, noted that Certificate No. 1209 would be subject to revocation if respondent failed to file the necessary insurance endorsement(s) and pay a \$50 late fee within thirty days. Respondent paid the \$50 late fee but has yet to file the necessary insurance endorsement(s). In the meantime, on May 3, 2007, respondent filed an application requesting voluntary termination of Certificate No. 1209.

The Commission may terminate a certificate of authority under Title II of the Compact, Article XI, Section 10(b), upon application by the holder.

The application shall be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 1209 is hereby terminated, effective this date.

2. That within 30 days from the date of this order applicant shall:

- a. remove from applicant's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61;
- b. file a notarized affidavit with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding requirement; and
- c. surrender Certificate No. 1209 to the Commission.
