Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 26 for a minimum of \$5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

The \$2 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on file for respondent terminated on July 1, 2007, without replacement. As a result, ~~Certificate No. 26 was automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-02, and a \$50 late filing fee became due and payable under Regulation No. 67-03(c), as noted in Order No. 10,590, served July 2, 2007.~~

Respondent filed an acceptable \$2 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on July 5, 2007, and tendered a \$50 money order on July 6, 2007. Accordingly, the suspension is lifted, and this investigation is terminated.
