Case No. MP-2007-036

Certificate No. 1227 was suspended on February 19, 2007, for respondent's willful failure to maintain a WMATC Insurance Endorsement on file with the Commission. Respondent thereafter filed a replacement endorsement but did not pay the \$50 late insurance fee under Regulation No. 67-03(c). Accordingly, Certificate No. 1227 was revoked on June 1, 2007, in Order No. 10,519. Respondent subsequently paid the fee and filed an application for reconsideration on June 8, 2007.

Under Title II of the Compact, Article XIII, Section 4(a), an application for reconsideration of a Commission order must be filed within thirty days of its publication and state specifically the errors claimed as grounds for reconsideration. The application for reconsideration was timely filed but does not allege any error on the part of the Commission. The application therefore is denied.

Further, considering that the replacement endorsement filed by respondent was cancelled effective May 21, 2007, and has not been replaced, we shall not reopen this proceeding under Commission Rule No. 26.<sup>1</sup>

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the application for reconsideration is denied.
2. That this proceeding is terminated.
