Case No. MP-2007-227

Certificate No. 910 was automatically suspended on November 2, 2007, pursuant to Regulation No. 58 for respondent's willful failure to maintain on file with the Commission proof of \$1.5 million in combined-single-limit, motor vehicle liability insurance as required by Commission Regulation No. 58. Order No. 10,880, served November 2, 2007, noted that Certificate No. 910 would be subject to revocation if respondent failed to file the necessary WMATC Insurance Endorsement(s), and pay a \$50 late fee within thirty days.

Respondent tendered \$50 cash on November 2, 2007, and the Commission reissued Certificate No. 910 to Amin Transportation Inc on November 9, 2007, pursuant to Order No. 10,503, served May 25, 2007, after Amin Transportation Inc had filed, among other things, a \$1.5 million WMATC Insurance Endorsement.

Inasmuch as respondent has paid the late fee and verified timely cessation of operations, as corroborated by respondent's sole client, Medical Transportation Management, Inc., and considering that Certificate No. 910 is no longer held by respondent, this proceeding is terminated.
