This matter is before the Commission on respondent's response to Order No. 10,792, served September 28, 2007.

The order stipulated that upon respondent's payment of a \$2,250 *civil* forfeiture and presentation of vehicles for inspection, the Commission would issue an order lifting the suspension of Certificate No. 489, subject to a one-year period of probation.

Respondent tendered a \$2,250 cashier's check on October 30, 2007, and respondent's revenue vehicles passed inspection on December 5, 2007.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the suspension of Certificate of Authority No. 489 is hereby lifted.
2. That respondent shall serve a one-year period of probation, such that a willful violation of the Compact, or of the Commission's rules, regulations or orders thereunder, during the period of probation shall constitute grounds for immediate suspension and/or revocation of Certificate No. 489 without further proceedings, regardless of the nature and severity of the violation.
3. That this proceeding is terminated.
