On November 9, 2007, at 12:01 a.m., EST, Certificate No. 1326 was automatically suspended pursuant to Regulation No. 58-02 for the failure of Med Trans Plus, LLC, to maintain on file with the Commission proof of \$1.5 million in combined-single-limit, motor vehicle liability insurance as required by Commission Regulation No. 58.

Order No. 10,894, served November 9, 2007, noted that Certificate No. 1326 would be subject to revocation if Med Trans Plus, LLC, failed to file the necessary insurance endorsement(s) and pay the \$50 late fee due under Regulation No. 67-03(c) within thirty days. Med Trans Plus, LLC, has yet to file the necessary insurance endorsement(s) and pay the late fee.

Instead, on November 9, 2007, after Certificate No. 1326 was already suspended, Med Trans Plus, LLC, filed an application requesting voluntary termination of Certificate No. 1326.

Although the Commission may terminate a certificate of authority under Title II of the Compact, Article XI, Section 10(b), upon application by the holder, voluntary termination is not available if the carrier is not in good standing with the Commission.¹

Because Med Trans Plus, LLC, is not in good standing with the Commission, having failed to pay the \$50 late fee, we shall deny the application for voluntary termination.²

Because Med Trans Plus, LLC, has failed to file the necessary insurance endorsement(s) and pay the \$50 late fee, Certificate No. 1326 shall be revoked pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact for the willful failure of Med Trans Plus, LLC, to comply

with Regulation No. 58, Regulation No. 67-03(c), and Order No. 10,894. The unpaid \$50 late fee shall remain due.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:


1. That the application of Med Trans Plus, LLC, for voluntary termination of Certificate No. 1326 is hereby denied.

2. That Certificate of Authority No. 1326 is hereby revoked.

3. That within 30 days from the date of this order Med Trans Plus, LLC, shall:

- a. remove from respondent's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61;
- b. file a notarized affidavit with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding requirement; and
- c. surrender Certificate No. 1326 to the Commission.
