Case No. MP-2007-249

Certificate No. 52 has been suspended since November 26, 2007, for respondent's willful failure to comply with the insurance requirements specified in Regulation No. 58. Order No. 10,931, served November 26, 2007, noted that Certificate No. 52 would be subject to revocation if respondent failed to file the necessary insurance endorsement(s) and pay a \$50 late fee within thirty days. Respondent also was directed to file a new tariff because the preexisting tariff was no longer effective. Respondent has yet to respond. Accordingly, Certificate No. 52 shall be revoked pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact.

Because this matter was ripe for decision in 2007, the annual report and annual fee for 2008 shall be waived, unless and until otherwise ordered.¹

The \$50 late fee shall remain due.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 52 is hereby revoked.
2. That the 2008 annual report and annual fee for Carrier No. 52 shall be waived unless and until otherwise ordered.
3. That within 30 days from the date of this order respondent shall:
 - a. remove from respondent's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61;
 - b. file a notarized affidavit with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding requirement; and
 - c. surrender Certificate No. 52 to the Commission.
