Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 143 for a minimum of \$5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

The \$5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on file for respondent terminated on February 6, 2008. Respondent earlier had faxed a \$1 million primary replacement endorsement on January 11 and filed an original \$4 million excess replacement endorsement on January 31. The excess endorsement was accepted for filing, but the primary was not because the Commission does not accept faxed endorsements.<sup>1</sup> As a result, Certificate No. 143 was automatically suspended on February 6 under Regulation No. 58-02, and a \$50 late filing fee became due and payable under Regulation No. 67-03(c), as noted in Order No. 11,146, served February 7, 2008.

Respondent filed an acceptable \$1 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on February 12, 2008 and the insurance company tendered a \$50 check on February 15, 2008. Accordingly, the suspension is lifted, and this investigation is terminated.
