By application filed January 31, 2008, Sanaga Services & Care LLC seeks voluntary termination of Certificate No. 1120.

The Commission may terminate a certificate of authority under Title II of the Compact, Article XI, Section 10(b), upon application by the holder, provided applicant is in good standing.<sup>1</sup>

Because applicant held Certificate No. 1120 on January 1 of this year, applicant was required to file an annual report for 2008 and pay an annual fee of \$150 on or before January 31 pursuant to Commission Regulation Nos. 60-01 and 67-02. Applicant has yet to pay the annual fee and file an acceptable annual report. Consequently, applicant now owes an additional \$200 in late fees pursuant to Regulation No. 67-03.

Inasmuch as applicant is not in good standing at this time, the application shall be denied, without prejudice to reapply once applicant has filed its annual report and paid the \$350 in outstanding fees.<sup>2</sup>

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the application of Sanaga Services & Care LLC for voluntary termination of Certificate No. 1120 is hereby denied without prejudice.
